FOCUSMAINE APPOINTS BIOECONOMY LEADER AS NEW PRESIDENT

PORTLAND, Maine (June 8, 2022)—FocusMaine, a private sector-led initiative to catalyze job growth and enhance the state's economy, announced today that Dana O'Brien will become the organization's next president.

O'Brien brings to FocusMaine significant experience in the private and government sectors. For more than a decade, he served in progressive management roles at the <u>Biotechnology Innovation Organization (BIO</u>), leading teams and building coalitions focused on transforming the U.S. economy into one centered on cutting-edge biology, technology, and sustainability. Most recently, as BIO's chief sustainability officer, O'Brien established the biotech industry's first sustainability policy and thought leadership program and helped guide BIO's strategic overhaul. Previously, as BIO's executive vice president, he secured bipartisan policies and diversified partnerships for BIO's food, farm, and environmental members. Prior to BIO, O'Brien spent more than 13 years on Capitol Hill in a senior policy role for a member of Congress.

Dana will become FocusMaine's second president, following Kimberly Hamilton who skillfully launched FocusMaine's programs and generated <u>significant successes and</u> <u>partnership growth</u> over the past five years. Dana will begin work with FocusMaine on June 13th.
